Do I need to Report or Disclaim APHIS Lacey Information for my Product(s)?

A disclaim is appropriate if APHIS Lacey does not regulate your product or if your product is regulated, but there are no date requirements.

IMPORTANT NOTE: APHIS will only require a declaration for new products in Harmonized Tariff Code 4415 that are formally entering the United States. The declaration requirement will not apply to used, recycled, or reclaimed pallets or to pallets, empty or under load, that are used to carry goods imported into the United States.

Additional information specific to Wood Packaging Materials and other used or reclaimed wood products -

Effective October 1, 2021, importers are required to file a Lacey declaration for new wooden products in HTSUS 4415 that are formally entering the United States as merchandise.

The Lacey Act provides an exception to the plant import declaration requirement for plants used exclusively as packaging material to support, protect, or carry another item, unless the packaging material itself is the item being imported (§ 3372(f)(3)). For these products, you can apply disclaimer code "A" to fulfill the Lacey message set requirements.
